- Llano National Bank offices will close at 3:00 pm on Friday, November 8th. Offices will not be open on Saturday, November 9th. The bank will also not be open on Monday, November 11th in observance of Veterans Day. Please plan accordingly. Normal hours will resume Tuesday, November 12th.
- Online banking, mobile banking, and bill pay access will be unavailable from approximately 6:00 pm on Friday, November 8th through approximately 8:00 am on Tuesday, November 12th.
- The debit card system should not be affected during the conversion weekend; however, we suggest you have an alternate form of payment available during the migration in case of any unplanned or unexpected interruptions.
- Your Llano National Bank account numbers will remain the same.
- All checking, savings, and money market accounts will receive a statement dated November 8th to coincide with the conversion. Statement dates will resume normal dates after conversion weekend meaning you may receive two statements in the month of November.
- ATMs will be available, but balance inquiries may not work during conversion weekend.
